2014: EU NFRD

 2015: SBTi on climate targets (9000 companies to date)

2019: SBTN on nature targets

2022: EU CSRD

CSRD on nature


- ESRS: major step forward
- Companies <u>must</u> disclose their available **targets** on pollution (ESRS E2), water and marine resources (ESRS E3), biodiversity and ecosystems (ESRS E4), circular economy (ESRS E5)
- Companies <u>can</u> disclose related available transition plans

WWF report 'Corporates Nature Targets'

- Nature targets should be:
 - (1) including the whole value chain
 - (2) geography-specific
 - (3) science-based
 - (4) time-bound
- Assessment of ESRS E2-E5: SBTN compares favourably
- SBTN available, still in development. Possible to use other anchor points to set nature targets (GBF, EU Green Deal) and cover material issues
- Coming: WWF Nature transition plans report

(5 steps: 1. Assess; 2. Prioritize; 3. Set targets; 4. Act; 5. Track)


EFRAG guidance (transition plans, early 2025; more)

EFRAG sector-specific standards – 10 priority sectors for 2026

Policy developments

- No rollback allowed for CSRD-ESRS. Such reporting is a must
- Reporting: only a means to and end. Align business models/ portfolios with public goals
- Inter-operability then upwards harmonisation necessary globally


For companies:


- Publicly engage in favour of CSRD & ESRS
